Scope of Works

- Modernisation of the Thyssen five-car lift group to Thames Valley Navigator Destination Control.
- Re-wiring of all five control panels serving the lift.
- Upgrading motors by removing redundant equipment and installing new gearless machines.
- Implementation of a 'Plant Movement Plan' to move equipment through the fully-occupied building safely.
- Manufacturisation of bespoke steelwork in-line with client specification.
- Provision and installation of bespoke touch screens and ID plates.
- Upgrading car interior finishes in-line with the building's surrounding aesthetics.
- Apex provided a 24 month defects liability period upon issue of the 'Taking Over Certificate.'
